



Data protection declaration regarding the processing of personal data within the framework of the "Boysen-TU Dresden-Research Training Group Autumn School"

For what purposes will personal data be processed?

We process your data for organizational and implementation purposes. We also use this data to send you possible notifications, itineraries, and newsletters relevant to the event. During the Autumn School we will take photos, videos, and voice recordings for documentation purposes and for public relations purposes at TU Dresden.

On what legal basis is the processing of personal data carried out?

The legal basis for data processing for the above-mentioned purposes is Article 6, Paragraph 1, Subparagraph 1, Letter a, and, if applicable, Article 9, Paragraph 2, Letter a, of the GDPR (consent).

For recordings that reflect the character of the location where the recording was made or the event (overview recordings), the legal basis includes Art. 6, Paragraph 1, subparagraph 1, Letter e in conjunction with Art. 6, Paragraph 3 of the GDPR, as well as Section 3, Paragraph 1 of the SächsDSDG.

Which personal data is processed?

The photo, video, and voice recordings which will be processed may include physically defining characteristics of your person (e.g. height and/or hair color may be determined from photos), the environment, your voice, and the content of the recordings (category A data). In addition, the following personal data is processed for registration and implementation of the event (category B data): (The data marked with an asterisk (*) is required for the organization and implementation of the event. The optional data helps us to better organize your registration.)

How is the personal data processed and how long is it stored?

All information that we collect to organize and carry out the event (i.e. category B data) will be treated confidentially, stored on TU Dresden servers, and deleted within 24 months of the end of the event.

The photo, video, and voice recordings (category A data) made on the day of the event will be published offline in (external and internal) presentations (poster presentations and conference contributions) and on the internet (Boysen-TUD Graduate College website, LinkedIn). The photo, video, and voice recordings will not focus on you as we will only publish overview photos and video recordings of the Autumn School rooms and the speakers. However, please do not hesitate to contact the photographers or us if you have any objections. This is the only way we can protect your rights and avoid recording you or delete a photo or video if you have already been recorded. We store the photo, video, and voice recordings for ten years. After this period has expired, they will be deleted and will no longer be publicly visible via the specified media. If you would like to have the photo, video and voice recordings deleted yourself in advance, you can send us a message directly. We will comply with the deletion request immediately.

Is personal data transmitted to third parties?

No, your personal data will not be passed on to third parties.

What rights do those affected generally have?

Voluntariness and revocation (Art. 7 Para. 3 GDPR)

Providing personal data is voluntary. Consent can be refused or revoked at any time informally and without giving reasons to the person responsible. Your personal data will then no longer be processed. However, it may be that you cannot take part in the event due to a revocation or objection (see below). The lawfulness of the processing carried out based on consent until its revocation remains unaffected by a revocation.

Right to information (Article 15 GDPR)

You have the right to request information at any time about the data processed about you and the possible recipients of this data. You are entitled to a response within one month of receipt of the request for information.

Right to correction, deletion, and restriction (Articles 16-18 GDPR)

You can request that TU Dresden correct or delete your personal data or restrict processing at any time.

Right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR)

You can request that the person responsible sends you your personal data in machine-readable form. Alternatively, you can request that the personal data you have provided be transmitted directly to another controller, where possible.

Right to object (Art. 21 GDPR)

You have the right, for reasons arising from your particular situation, to object at any time to the processing of personal data concerning you which is carried out on the basis of Article 6, Paragraph 1, Subparagraph 1, Letter e of the GDPR.

Right to complain (Art. 77 GDPR)

You can contact the data protection officer at TU Dresden at any time (see above) or, if you have a complaint in accordance with Art. 77 GDPR, the responsible data protection supervisory authority.
