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Introduction

(Cash) Income from other sources than own farm:


- "Out-Farm Labour": Employed on-farm labour on foreign farm
- "Off-Farm Labour": Employed or self-employed labour not on-farm
- "Money Transfers": Usually relatives sending money or rent payments

Theoretical framework:

- Push & Pull modell of migration by E.S. Lee
- People turn away from traditional subsistance agriculture due to Push factores
- Pull factores attract them to an other area






Is there Migration?





Age distribution in the Achamayo region (La Libertad, La Florida, Marcatuna)

"Could you live without other income?"







Why do people work Out- & Off-Farm?



"Other" Reasons:

- Only if there is no work on own farm
- It is less risky
- To earn cash
- To have a continous income



Conclusion

- Migration is a mayor issue in the Achamayo region
- Strong effect of connection to urban areas and markets.
- Self-sufficient agriculture often not possible / Desire for improoved living
- "Old lifestyle" not desirable
