# **Day 1** 10 June 2024

We will start the workshop with an update and progress report on the achievements since the last partner workshop in Bangkok (October 2023). The rest of the day will be spent on the current status of our joint online teaching course, "SDG Contributions from Forest Landscapes". During our last meeting in Bangkok, we jointly developed the course structure, drafted the course syllabus, and identified the including sessions, the potential lecturers. that each partner has committed to contribute to the joint course. Meanwhile, the first two sessions have been produced and made available to the partner consortium as an orientation and template for the production of the remaining sessions.

During the meeting in Tharandt, each partner should give an update on the state of development of their sessions and, if available, provide brief insights into already produced sessions. Each partner will have 25 minutes to present, followed by 20 minutes of discussion. In addition to the current state of development and the progress, also should include presentation technical challenges and organizational issues that arose during the production process. As we are still in the early stages, the collective reflection will help us to find solutions to further improve the quality of your common online course.

The day will end with a visit to the "Amazonia" exhibition at the Panometer in Dresden, which includes the world's largest 360° panoramic tropical rainforest painting.

Afterward, we will have dinner together in Dresden.



Day 2 11 June 2024

On the morning of day 2, we will continue with our joint online teaching module and come up with a roadmap to complete the course by November 2024.

Afterward, we will turn our attention to the Global-SDG-Campus Collaboration Agreement (MoU+), which will provide the institutional basis for our future collaboration and the basis for a followup project proposal to the DAAD (2026-2029). The draft of the collaboration agreement that we developed together in Bangkok was circulated among the partners in April 2024 for internal administrative reflection. During this workshop in Tharandt, each partner now has the chance to provide feedback on the existing draft, on the basis of which we will move forward and try to finalize the agreement for signature.

To this end, each partner should thoroughly review the draft Cooperative Agreement for content and wording and consider at which administrative level the document should be signed.

After that, we will do the rough planning for the year 2025, which will lead to a brainstorming session to explore ideas and potentials for a follow-up project proposal with the DAAD, which would have to be submitted by June 2025. Therefore, each partner should recall the past 2.5 years and critically reflect on our activities, achievements, and challenges and come up with ideas on how to further develop our Global-SDG-Campus initiative in the coming years.

A barbecue in the institute garden will round off the day.





Day 3 12 June 2024



On the third day of the workshop, we will gather in the morning for a brainstorming explore possibilities session to and generate ideas for advancing the Global-SDG-Campus initiative. Later in the afternoon, we will summarize our discussions and sketch out initial plans for follow-up actions, including potential collaboration with the DAAD for further support.
