

**First statute**  
**on the amendment of the Regulations for Assessing the Aptitude**  
**for the Master's Degree Program Hydro Science and Engineering**  
**(Aptitude Assessment Regulations Hydro Science and Engineering)**

as of March 17, 2021

On the basis of § 13 paragraph 4 § 17 paragraphs 6 and 10 of the Act on the Autonomy of Institutions of Higher Education in the Free State of Saxony in the version of the announcement of January 15, 2013 (SächsGVBl. p. 3), Technische Universität Dresden issues the following study regulations as statutes, last amended by Article 5 of the Act of December 17, 2020 (SächsGVBl. p. 731).

**Article 1**  
**Amendment to the Aptitude Assessment Regulations**

The Regulations for Assessing the Aptitude for the Master's degree program Hydro Science and Engineering of 17<sup>th</sup> December 2019 (Official Announcements of TU Dresden No. 01/2020 of 29<sup>th</sup> January 2020, p. 82), are amended as follows:

§ 4 paragraph 1 is formulated in the following way:

„(1) The form for assessing the special aptitude according to these regulations of the Master's Degree Program Hydro Science and Engineering is part of the required documents for enrollment and must be submitted in due time and in the correct form.

1. Applicants with a university degree obtained in Germany (entrance qualification for a Master's degree) must apply to the following address:
  - a) Applicants with a German citizenship or those with a non-German citizenship but the German *Abitur* qualification, must apply to the following address:

Immatrikulationsamt (*Admissions Office*)

  - b) Applicants with non-German citizenship and an international qualification equivalent to the *Abitur* are to submit their application to the following address:  
Technische Universität Dresden  
SG Internationales  
01062 Dresden  
Germany
2. Applicants with a university degree obtained outside Germany (entrance qualification for a Master's degree program) must apply via uni-assist.
3. Applicants with citizenship outside the EU who have obtained their university degree (entrance qualification for a Master's degree program) at a non-German university must apply for the winter semester by May 31. All other German and international applicants must apply for the winter semester by July 15.“

**Article 2**  
**Entry into force and publication**

This statute amendment shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Announcements of TU Dresden.
