**Statutes
for the Amendment of the Examination Regulations
for the consecutive Master Degree Programme Hydro Science and
Engineering**

as of 7th September 2018

On the basis of §34 para. 1 sentence 1 of the Act on the Autonomy of Institutions of Higher Education in the Free State of Saxony in the version published on 15th January 2013 (SächsGVBl. Technische Universität Dresden issues the following amendments to the statutes.

**Article 1
Amendment of the Examination Regulations**

The Examination Regulations for the consecutive Master Degree Programme Hydro Science and Engineering of 14th February 2017 (Official Announcements of TU Dresden No. 02/2017 of 23rd February 2017, p. 39), which were last amended by the Statutes of 10th March 2018 (Official Announcements of TU Dresden No. 04/2018 of 21st March 2018, p. 10), are amended as follows:

1. § 26 is amended as follows:
 - a) The wording becomes paragraph 1.
 - b) The following paragraph 2 shall be added
"(2) In order to be assigned the topic of the Master thesis, at least 60 credit points must have been earned.
2. In § 28 para. 1 sentence 1, the words "four months" shall be replaced by the words "twenty-one weeks".

**Article 2
Entry into force, publication and transitional provisions**

This amendment shall enter into force on 1st October 2018 and shall be published in the Official Announcements of Technische Universität Dresden.

It applies to all new students enrolled in the Master Degree Programme Hydro Science and Engineering in the winter semester 2018/2019 or later.

For students enrolled earlier than winter semester 2018/2019, the current version of the examination regulations for the consecutive Master Degree Programme Hydro Science and Engineering continues to apply unless they declare their transition to the new examination regulations in writing to the Examination Committee. The form and deadline for the declaration will be determined by the Examination Committee and will be announced in accordance with standard faculty practice.

It applies from winter semester 2019/2020 to all students enrolled in the consecutive Master Degree Programme Hydro Science and Engineering.
