

**Third Statute
for the Amendment of the Examination Regulations
for the consecutive Master Degree Programme Hydro Science
and Engineering**

as of 17th December 2019

On the basis of §34 para. 1 sentence 1 of the Act on the Autonomy of Institutions of Higher Education in the Free State of Saxony in the version published on 15th January 2013 (SächsGVBl. Technische Universität Dresden issues the following amending statutes.

**Article 1
Amendment of the Examination Regulations**

The Examination Regulations for the consecutive Master Degree Programme Hydro Science and Engineering of 14th February 2017 (Official Announcements of TU Dresden No. 02/2017 of 23rd February 2017, p. 39), which were last amended by the Statutes of 7th September 2018 (Official Announcements of TU Dresden No. 21/2018 of 25th September 2018, p. 157), are amended as follows

1. In § 12 para. 3 sentence 2, the number "30" shall be replaced by the number "45".
2. The following sentence shall be added to § 25 para. 2
"Within the framework
 1. of the Erasmus Joint Master Degree Programme "GroundwatCh - Groundwater and Global Change - Impacts and Adaptation", it is possible to begin studies with a cooperation partner in accordance with the cooperation agreement, to continue after the first year of study at Technische Universität Dresden and to complete the studies at Technische Universität Dresden or with a cooperation partner or
 2. of the Erasmus Joint Master Degree Programme "FLOODRisk - Flood Risk Management" in accordance with the cooperation agreement to complete the second and third semester with a cooperation partner and to complete the studies at Technische Universität Dresden or with a cooperation partner".

**Article 2
Entry into force, publication and transitional provisions**

1. This amendment shall enter into force on 1st April 2018 and shall be published in the Official Announcements of Technische Universität Dresden.
2. It applies to all new students enrolled in the Master Degree Programme Hydro Science and Engineering in the winter semester 2020/2021 or later.
3. For students enrolled earlier than winter semester 2020/2021, the current version of the examination regulations for the consecutive Master Degree Programme Hydro Science and Engineering continues to apply unless they declare their transfer in writing to the Examination Committee. The form and deadline for the declaration will be determined by the Examination Committee and will be announced in accordance with standard faculty practice.
