

**Second Statute
for the Amendment of the Study Regulations
for the consecutive Master's degree program Hydro Science and
Engineering**

as of December 17, 2019

On the basis of § 36 para. 1 of the Act on the Autonomy of Institutions of Higher Education in the Free State of Saxony in the version published on January 15, 2013 (SächsGVBl. p. 3) Technische Universität Dresden issues the following amending statutes:

**Article 1
Amendment of the Study Regulations**

The Study Regulations for the consecutive Master's Degree Program Hydro Science and Engineering of February 14, 2017 (Official Announcement of TU Dresden No. 02/2017 of February 23, 2017, p. 2), amended by statutes of September 07, 2018 (Official Announcements 21/2018 of September 25, 2018, p. 155) are amended as follows:

1. § 3 is amended as follows:

a) paragraph 2 will be formulated in the following way:

“(2) Furthermore, knowledge of English at C1 level of the Common European Framework of Reference for Language is a prerequisite. Proof thereof is a relevant examination certificate or language certificate. This may be a certificate of general or subject-specific university entrance qualification with an advanced course completed in English, a certificate for entrance into higher education completed in English, a higher education graduation certificate completed in English or an English language certificate (for example TOEFL, IELTS, UNICert®).

b) para. 3 is formulated as follows:

“(3) In addition, a special aptitude is required. Proof of this particular aptitude is provided by an assessment in accordance with the Aptitude Assessment Regulations for Science and Engineering.”

2. In § 6 para. 1, the following sentence shall be added:

“There is the possibility, within the framework

1. of the Erasmus Joint Master's Degree Program GroundwatCh - Ground Water and Global Change - Impacts and Adaptation in accordance with the cooperation agreement to commence studies with a cooperation partner, to continue the studies after the first year at Technische Universität Dresden and to complete them there or at a cooperation partner, or

2. within the framework of the Erasmus Joint Master's Degree Program FLOODRisk - Flood Risk Management in accordance with the cooperation agreement to complete the second and third semester at a cooperation partner and to finish the studies at Technische Universität Dresden or at a cooperation partner.”

**Article 2
Entry into Force, Publication, and Interim Arrangements**

1. This amendment shall enter into force on 1st April 2020 and shall be published in the Official Announcements of Technische Universität Dresden.

2. The announcements apply to all students enrolled in the Master's program Hydro Science and Engineering in the 2020/2021 winter semester or later.
3. For students who enrolled earlier than in the 2020/2021 winter semester, the version of the Study Regulations for the consecutive Master's degree program Hydro Science and Engineering that has been valid for them up until the amendment continues to apply unless they declare their acceptance of the amendment in writing. The form and deadline of this declaration are specified by the Examination Committee and announced as is customary at the Faculty.
