

**Fourth statute
for the Amendment of the Examination Regulations
for the consecutive Master's degree program Hydro Science and En-
gineering**

as of September 15, 2020

On the basis of § 34 para. 1 sentence 1 of the Act on the Autonomy of Institutions of Higher Education in the Free State of Saxony in the version published on January 15, 2013 (SächsGVBl. p. 3) Technische Universität Dresden issues the following amending statutes:

**Article 1
Amendment to the Examination Regulations**

The Examination Regulations for the consecutive Master's Degree Program Hydro Science and Engineering of February 14, 2017 (Official Announcement of TU Dresden No. 02/2017 of February 23, 2017, p. 39), amended most recently by the statutes of December 17, 2019 (Official Announcements 03/2020 of March 06, 2020, p. 6) are amended as follows:

1. In § 14 para. 5, the following sentence shall be added:
In the case that a module examination is irreversibly failed in the elective compulsory field, the irrevocable failure of the Master's examination is only declared according to § 18 para. 4 if, within one month after the publication of the module examination results, the student does not change their module or if a change of the module according to § 6 para. 2 sentence 5 of the Study Regulations is no longer possible. If a student has irreversibly failed the Master's examination, the student loses the right to take examinations for all parts of the Master's examination according to § 2 sentence 1."
2. § 27 is amended as follows:
 - a) Paragraph 2 shall be formulated in the following way:
"(2) Modules of the compulsory area are
 1. Statistics (Angewandte Statistik)
 2. Climatology and Hydrology (Klimatologie und Hydrobiologie)
 3. Study Project Integrated Water Resources Management (IWRM) (Projektstudium IWRM)."
 - b) Paragraph 3 shall be amended as follows:
 - aa) After the words „Modules of the elective compulsory area“, the words
 - „1. Soils (Bodenkunde)
 2. Ecology (Ökologie)
 3. Hydrochemistry (Hydrochemie),of which two must be chosen, as well as
 4. Geodesy (Geodäsie)
 5. Hydromechanics (Hydromechanik)
 6. Hydraulic Engineering (Wasserbau),of which two must be chosen, as well as" shall be added.
 - bb) The previous numbers 1 to 17 shall now be the numbers 7 to 23.

**Article 2
Entry into Force, Publication, and Interim Arrangements**

(1) This statute amendment shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Announcements of TU Dresden.

(2) This apply to all students enrolled in the Master's program Hydro Science and Engineering in the 2020/2021 winter semester or later.

(3) For students who enrolled earlier than in the 2020/2021 winter semester, the version of the Examination Regulations for the consecutive Master's degree program Hydro Science and Engineering that has been valid for them up until the amendment continues to apply unless they declare their acceptance of the amendment in writing. The form and deadline of this declaration are specified by the Examination Committee and announced as is customary at the Faculty.
