2 Offers General Qualification Module VW-TEc-MA-AQUA

A total of at least 3 SWS of courses must be taken. Courses can be attended and examinations can be taken if the respective examiner agrees to the taking of the examination. This must be clarified in advance by the student on his/her own responsibility. The performances rendered are to be proven with graded examination performances, which are the basis for the formation of the module grade according to the module description. According to the module description, 5 LP can be acquired. The module "Additional General Qualifications" is a module of the module group "Supplements".
