

## TALENT CULTIVATION


### "Three-System" Training




### Liberal Education

In 2011, the Shanghai University began to fully implement the major categories of admission and liberal education, which consists of six modules: "Humanities Classics and Cultural Heritage", "Political Civilization and Social Construction", "Artistic Cultivation and Aesthetic Experience", "Economic Development and Global Vision", "Technological Progression and Ecological Civilization", and Innovative Thinking and Entrepreneurship Education". The university currently has 258 general elective courses, 54 core liberal studies courses and 425 professor-instructed freshman seminars.
