Direction II additionally allows you to realize a clerkship and therewith teach at a vocational school, after finishing a corresponding Master program.



# **Program Syllabus**

- The Bachelor program consists of modules in a broad compulsory part, a mandatory part with various specialization possibilities, and the Bachelor thesis. The workload comprises 180 credit points. Every semester 30 credit points are awarded.
- You may choose between two study directions I und II. Study direction I is business-oriented, while direction II combines topics in business and economics with an additionally chosen qualification.
- The mandatory core modules teach fundamentals in Business Management, Economics, Business Informatics, Law, Mathematics, and Statistics. Furthermore, you have to realize practical studies in a school and a practical school training. When choosing Direction II, you additionally take mandatory courses in your chosen qualification option.
- The elective modules allow you to choose modules of interest in the areas of: Business Education, Business Management, Economics, and an additional field.
- The program is completed in the 6th semester with a Bachelor thesis.
