Research Topic

The aim of this master thesis is to identify and critically analyze current approaches to impact of businesses on a sustainable development. Methodologically, the thesis will contain a systematic literature review. Thus, academic literature forms the relevant set of data. The systematic review should address the following questions:

- How is impact conceptualized in different research fields at the intersection of sustainability and entrepreneurship/management?
- Which impact assessment approaches are discussed in the scholarly discourse?
- How can these discourses be synthesized into one framework?

You are free to shape the detailed research focus and research design according to your own interest, in consultation with the supervisors.

- Educational focus on sustainability management, sustainable entrepreneurship, management of technology, social and environmental sciences, or a related course with very good grades
- Interest in impact assessment, environmental and sustainability management, sustainability performance and sustainability assessment
