Born in Waldenburg on November 27, 1952, Dr. Viehweger studied nuclear physics from 1973 to 1978 at the TU Dresden. From 1985 to 1990 he was head of the department energy of the City of Dresden. From April to September 1990 Dr. Viehweger was Minister of Construction, Urban Planning and Housing in the Cabinet of Lothar de Maizière. He was a member of the Saxon Landtag from 1990 to 1994. Since 2002 he is member of the executive board of the Verband Sächsischer Wohnungsgenossenschaften e. V.

Demography - shaping shrinkage, technical assistance systems, low barrier and barrier-free living space design, various forms of living, rearrangement of the residential environment and the living quarter, social services and social network design, awareness and empowerment/competence transfer, transition processes between domesticity and health professionals, dementia and care, movement and mobility, volunteering and commitment, electric mobility
