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ABOUT EAT2018

The Education and Technology Research Training Network and Summer School (EAT 2018) aims to explore and enhance career opportunities for doctoral and postdoctoral researchers in the interdisciplinary field of research in Educational Science, Information Technology, and Digital Culture. Particular attention will be given to exploring the value of developing transferable digital skills and intercultural skills, as well as of committing to international mobility.

Background: The EAT doctoral network is the result of previous efforts (deployed since 2007 and involving more than 300 participants) to internationalise and promote doctoral research across partners with the aim of improving the scientific quality, international scientific competitiveness of candidates, and improve the professional visibility of young researchers during and after their PhD.

Target groups: In 2018, PhD researchers, more than ever, face serious challenges when considering a postdoctoral career. The most crucial challenges are (1) to find suitable multidisciplinary support and theoretical access to the pursued doctoral subject, (2) to acquire and capitalise on transferrable skills and intercultural skills, (3) to integrate efficient research mobility and internationalisation as part of doctoral and postdoctoral training, and (4) to achieve high competitiveness for successfully obtaining financial and institutional support for postdoctoral research in Europe and elsewhere, e.g., obtaining Marie Curie grants or being successfully included in ERC grants.

Rationale: In universities, prevailing expectations of successfully being awarded externally funded projects tend to oversee the strong need for

personnel development of young doctoral researchers and, as well, for early planning of the transition phase from doctoral to postdoctoral research. Postdoctoral researchers are also facing the same kind of challenges.

Novel approaches: The EAT European doctoral network has been predominantly focusing in previous years on individual process support in PhD project achievement and networking. EAT2018 will capitalise on previous successes in this area to develop fresh approaches to increasing the qualification of doctoral candidates, as well as offering direct support to participants in their concrete research situation and career planning.

Activities: Five « Breakfast Talks » Sessions will pool together experts in the field of research career development and junior researchers. Regular afternoon sessions will address two interrelated strands: (1) project-specific peer group interaction between junior and senior researchers. Each doctoral and postdoctoral participant will present his/her current project, focusing on the conceptual framework, workflow and project progress; (2) "myself"-oriented career interaction, focusing on the participants' career plans, e.g., mapping opportunities, resources and obstacles. Each dimension will involve briefing and debriefing on a peer-basis by co-participants. Plenary sessions will be devoted to discussing common issues and sharing findings. Informal events will be organised to foster social interaction between participants.

Academic recognition: PhD students who have participated in the full programme will be awarded 5 EC TS.

Local transportation

From Bergen airport to city centre

To travel from Bergen airport to Bergen centre, you can take the Bergen Light Rail, the Airport bus (Flybussen) or a taxi.

Bergen Light Rail (Bybane)

The cheapest means of transportation is the Bergen Light Rail (37 NOK $\approx 4 \in$); the trip to downtown takes about 40 minutes.

Busses to Montana Youth Hostel

Once in the city centre, bus lines 3 and 12 stop close to Montana Youth Hostel.



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Where and how to buy Light Rail and bus tickets

You can buy a ticket at the ticket machine at the airport baggage claim or at some bus stops with a credit card or Norwegian cash. These tickets are to be used <u>immediately</u>, and are valid for 90 <u>minutes only</u>; transfers and return on the same line are admitted.

You cannot buy tickets from the ticket machine for a later use (after 90 minutes) as they will be invalid.

Open tickets for later use can be bought at the following places (drugstores): Deli de Luca, 7-Eleven, Narvesen, and Bunnpris.

Tickets bought directly from bus drivers cost 50 NOK≈ 5.5 € !

Visa requirements

EU / EEA citizens can enter without restriction. You will need a valid passport.

Non-EU citizen without residence permit in the EU-EEA countries or visa applying to the Schengen area, or from visa exemption countries, will need to apply for a visa. UiB will issue a formal invitation. Make sure to comply we these formalities in time.


