



Information about the interim evaluation

Maria Reiche Programme to support academic careers of postdoctoral early-career female scientists

Pursuant to the regulations of the Maria Reiche Programme, after 12 months of funding, the candidates who receive funding are obliged to write a short report containing information about work progress and the results they have achieved so far (submission of the grant proposal).

Ideally, you submitted the application to the external funder within the first 12 months of the funding period. The extension of the funding period by six months allows you to make corrections to the application in accordance with the suggestions made by the external funder and to continue your research career (publications, lectures etc.).

Please submit the short report not later than two weeks after the twelve months are over to:

The interim evaluation includes a short report and also an oral presentation of the work progress and the results achieved before the selection panel. Afterwards, the selection panel decides whether a maximum extension of six months will be granted.

Please note that the funding period ends as soon as you will be financed as a project employee following a successful external funding application.

Please make sure that the written short report is not longer than five pages and explicitly answers the following questions:

- Which of the tasks described in the application have been completed so far?
- Which of the objectives described in the application have been fulfilled so far?
- Were you able to maintain the time schedule set up in the application?
- When did or will you submit the planned application for external funding? Have you got any feedback on your application from the external funder? If yes, what did it say?

- What tasks will you be performing in the remaining funding period?
- If you wish to request an extension of the funding period by a maximum of six months, produce a detailed work plan to justify the necessity of the request (work schedule).

The duration of the oral presentation before the members of the selection panel shall be approximately 15 minutes. If you wish to renew funding, a discussion of the results and the work schedule provided in the short report will be held as part of the presentation.
