# **Good Scientific Practice**



All members and employees of TU Dresden are obliged to observe the **Statute for Safeguarding Good Scientific Practice, for Avoiding Scientific Misconduct and for Dealing with Violations** as the basis of their scientific work and to contribute actively to avoiding scientific misconduct within their sphere of responsibility.

It is important to get to know the standards and principles of good scientific practice as early as possible in order to avoid unpleasant surprises later! The GA supports you with a broad training and advisory service specifically developed for your needs.

In **case of conflict** there are various places at TU Dresden for you to go to in order to confidentially seek for support and advice. These are:

- the Graduate Academy
- the ombudsperson of TU Dresden
- liaison officer for early-career researchers
- the Office for Good Scientific Practice

The **Service Center Research Data** offers a comprehensive consulting service for the management of research data.

### Workshops in the GA qualification program

As part of the GA qualification program, workshops on good scientific practice are held regularly in German and English.
