- Open to all doctoral candidates and their supervisors as well as to all postdocs
- Founded in 2013 (Excellence Initiative)




» Aim of the program:

The Free State of Saxony provides funding for the promotion of PhD students of the TU Dresden.

The scholarships are intended to support especially qualified applicants.

» Application deadline:

31st March 2023









» Eligibility:

Eligible are:

+ all prospective doctoral candidates at TU Dresden

Not eligible are:

- Individuals, who already started the PhD project
 - <u>Please note:</u> According to the "Sächsische Haushaltsordnung", only doctoral projects that <u>have not yet been</u> started at the time of application are eligible for funding. The acceptance as a doctoral candidate at the respective faculty is considered as the official start of the PhD. At the time of application, <u>no acceptance at the faculty</u> may have taken place.
- Individuals, who are already publicly funded otherwise.
- Individuals, who receives funding for the project from private institutions.
- Individuals, who have legal claim to such funding.







» Duration of funding:

- awarded for a period of three years
- extension for one more year is possible

» Extent of funding:

- monthly grant rate: EUR 1,350
- if applicable, a monthly family allowance of EUR 100 per child
- special allowances for material and travel expenses as well as for the costs of a research stay abroad: EUR 1,500

» Aim of the program:

The TU Dresden promotes with the Maria Reiche Doctoral Fellowships (without Faculty of Medicine) (prospective) female doctoral candidates with a full scholarship for up to 3 years.

» Application deadline:

31st March 2023









» Eligibility:

Eligible are:

- + Female graduates, who intend to earn a doctoral degree at TU Dresden.
- + Female graduates, who are not working more than two years on their doctorate and whose funding by scholarships, third-party funds etc. has expired. The two years are considered to be completed latest in the month before the requested funding period starts.

Not eligible are:

- Doctoral candidates of the faculty of medicine.
- Female researchers, who are employed as a research assistant (for 19 hours per week) during the applied period of funding.
- Female researchers, who hold an employment relationship or receive funding from another institution (such as private funding institutions, industry) during the applied period of funding.







» Duration of funding:

- maximum 3 years
- extension not possible

» Extent of funding:

- Monthly grant rate: EUR 1,365
- if applicable, a family allowance of EUR 400 for the first and EUR 100 for each additional child.

» Aim of the program:

The aim of the funding is to exploit the individual educational potential of academic specialists, by expanding their skills with regard to a stable, green, sustainable and digital economy in the Free State of Saxony.

» Application deadline: not announced by now







» Eligibility:

Eligible are:

- all prospective doctoral candidates at TU Dresden, provided that the doctoral thesis topic meets the above criteria.
- + Doctoral students of the TU Dresden, if the funding serves the continuation of the scientific research after a family-related interruption (at least six months)

Not eligible are:

- Individuals, who have already been employed (at least three years) as junior researchers in a junior research group or REACT research group funded by the ESF/ESF Plus.
- Individuals, who have already received other doctoral funding before submitting their application (doctoral scholarships from organisations for the promotion of the gifted, foundations, state funding programs, DAAD, etc.).
- Federal innovation doctorates: Individuals, who already started the PhD project
 Please note: The acceptance as a doctoral candidate at the respective faculty is considered as the official start of the PhD. At the time of application, no acceptance at the faculty may have taken place.







» Funding forms:

- Federal innovation doctorates should explore topics which are of special interest to the Free State of Saxony and which are expected to have an impact on the Saxon labour market.
- Industry-sponsored doctorates are of common interest of an involved third party (companies) based in the Free State of Saxony and the Technische Universität Dresden
- Doctorates improving the reconcilability of scientific career and family serve
 the continuation of the doctorate after a family-related interruption (at least 6 month) of academic
 research
- Combination of industry-sponsored doctorate and doctorate improving the reconcilability of scientific career and family







» Duration of funding:

- maximum 4 years
- Extension for 1 further year possible (individual case decision)

» Extent of funding:

- Monthly grant rate: EUR 1,700
- for industrial doctorates: co-financing by the participating third parties (company) of at least 850 EUR per month
- if applicable, a family allowance of EUR 100 per child

» Start of funding:

- Earliest start of grant: not announced by now
- Latest possible start of grant: not announced by now

Sideline activities

Sideline activities with a maximum of 10 hours per week are allowed

The sideline activity must not be related to the academic research







» Specific aspects of the program:

Qualification

In addition to working on their doctorate, doctoral candidates must develop their individual potential, including their knowledge of gender equality and within qualification areas of teaching, social skills and project management.

Selection Procedure

Special recognition will be given to doctoral projects which

- are practice-oriented or interdisciplinary research,
- involve the development of competencies in the field of the European Green Deal,
- include the development of competences in the field of digitisation
- are realised by women in the MINT or KI fields, or
- are based in the cultural field.

Supporting doctoral candidates during the final stage and wrap-up phase of their doctorate

» Eligibility:

Eligible are doctoral candidates in the final stage/wrapup phase of their doctorate, whose current financial support (e.g. scholarships, work contracts and/or third party funding) has expired.











» Duration of funding:

Maximum 3 months

» Extent of funding:

- Monthly grant for doctoral candidates: EUR 1,365 [exception Dr. med.: 861 EUR]
- Monthly grant for postdoctoral candidates: EUR 1,750
- NEW: a non-personnel monthly cost subsidy of EUR 103
- if applicable, a monthly family allowance of EUR 400 for the first and EUR 100 for each additional child.

Completion Grant

Start of funding: max. 3 months <u>before submission</u> of

the <u>dissertation</u>

Duration of funding: max. 3 months

Completion & Wrap-up Grant

Start of funding: At least one month <u>before</u> the planned <u>defense</u>

Duration of funding: max. 3 months

Wrap-up Grant

Start of funding: from the defense/rigorosum

Duration of funding: up to 2 months after defense

» Aim of the program:

The Free State of Saxony provides funding for

- Back-to-Research Grants for doctoral/postdoctoral research projects after a family-related interruption (Program line 1)
- Back-to-Research Grants for the resumption of scientific work of female postdocs to initiate an appointment to an university position (Program line 2)

» Application deadlines:

- 31st March 2023 Earliest start of grant: 1st July 2023
- **30th September 2023**Earliest start of grant: 1st January 2024









<u>Back-to-Research Grants for doctoral/postdoctoral research projects after</u> <u>a family-related interruption</u> (Program line 1)

» Eligibility:

Eligible are:

- + Researchers, who return to academia after having intermitted their scientific career at an advanced stage (for at least nine months) due to family commitments, to complete their doctorate and habilitation. The thesis has to be already at an advanced stage.
- + Researchers, who completed in case of a doctoral project the last university degree with an overall grade of at least "good" and in case of a habilitation project the doctorate have been assessed at least with "magna cum laude".
- + PhD students, who are not older than 37 and postdocs, who are not older than 42 years.

Not eligible are:

- Researchers, who are already publicly funded otherwise.
- Researchers, with sideline activities of more than 10 hours per week







» Duration of funding:

- scholarship funding ends with the month in which the dissertation/habilitation thesis is submitted, maximum funding period of 12 months
- extension of funding up to six additional months is possible

» Extent of funding:

- monthly grant rate for doctoral candidates: EUR 985
- monthly grant rate for habilitation candidates: EUR 1,285
- if applicable, a monthly family allowance of EUR 100 per child

Sideline activities

- Sideline activities with a maximum of 10 hours per week allowed
- The sideline activities have to be related to the PhD project and serve the purpose of the scholarship
- Minor teaching activity is Permitted
 - 2 hours per week for doctorates

<u>Back-to-Research Grants for the resumption of scientific work of female postdocs to initiate an appointment to an university position</u> (Program line 2)

» Eligibility:

Eligible are:

- + Female postdocs who return to academia after they have gained at least 3 years of qualified professional experience outside academia/university. The overall aim has to be gaining an appointment to an university position
- + Researchers, who completed the doctorate at least with "magna cum laude".
- + Female postdocs, who are not older than 40 years.

» Duration of funding:

Maximum of 6 months

» Extent of funding:

- monthly grant rate for habilitation candidates: EUR 1,285
- if applicable, a monthly family allowance of EUR 100 per child







» Application:

- Submission of the application only via regular mail to: Graduate Academy of TU Dresden
- Submission of the application only in German
- Signed copy of the online proposal form

- ✓ Proof on a professional experience outside the university sector of at least three years








» Aim of the program:

This grant aim to support the international visibility of the research achievements of doctoral candidates and postdocs. For this purpose the Graduate Academy of the TU Dresden grants allowances for proofreading services (German or English) for foreign-language publications from doctoral candidates and postdocs of TU Dresden.









» Eligibility:

- + Eligible are doctoral candidates and postdocs of TU Dresden of all faculties
- + If the proofreading service is for joint publications, the applicant has to be at least secondary author.
- » Application deadline: Applications can be submitted at any time
- » Maximum funding: maximum EUR 300.00

Please note:

- Allowances can only be requested before the actual utilization of the proofreading service.
- The original invoice must be submitted to the Graduate Academy no later than four months after the positive decision.







» Extent of funding for doctoral candidates:

- ✓ special chapters of the dissertation (release version to be submitted to a publishing house)
- ✓ article (full paper)
- ✓ extended abstracts
- ✓ exposés
- ✓ essays
- ✓ reviews in journals

Important!

The planned publication has to have a comprehensible relevance for the doctorate and/or scientific career.







» Extent of funding for Postdocs:

- ✓ Journal article (full paper)
- ✓ application for third-party funding (Application for own project only)

» Awarding criteria:

- Importance of the publication for the doctorate / academic career
- Reputation of the journal, book series, conference, exhibition etc.
- Needof proofreading
- Previous funding of the applicant for the use of proofreading services (plurality demand)

A fundamental legal right to claim an allowance for proofreading services does not exist.








» Aim of the program:

Support of excellent female postdocs in their intention to independently acquire a third-party funded project in order to qualify for a scientific career at the TU Dresden with the goal of becoming a professor.

» Application deadline: 30th April 2023









» Eligibility:

Eligible are:

+ Female scientists who have completed their doctorate no longer than six years ago.

The six years are completed no later than the month before the requested start of funding. In the case of maternity leave and parental leave(s) taken between the completion of the doctorate and the month before the requested start of funding, these will be counted towards the six years.

Not eligible are:

- Female researchers, who hold an employment relationship during the applied period of funding, which, by its type and extent, compromises the purpose of the scholarship.
- Female researchers, who who are already being funded by other institutions (e.g. private foundations, industrial companies) for the same purpose







» Duration of funding:

up to 24 months

» Extent of funding:

- monthly grant rate: EUR 2,670
- if applicable, a monthly family allowance of EUR 400 for the first and EUR 100 for each additional child
- Subsidies for the basic equipment of the workplace at the respective professorship/research institution of the TU Dresden
- Maria Reiche Starter Kit: max. EUR 10,000

» Start of funding:

- Earliest start of grant: 1st October 2023
- Latest possible start of grant: 1st January 2024



Sideline activities with a maximum of 10 hours per week are allowed

- Abstract (incl. "TU Dresden" in the author's address, can be handed in later)
- Copy of the acceptance of your participation and contribution (can be handed in later)
- Program of the event (can be handed in later)
- For doctoral candidates & postdocs: 1 Letter of recommendation
- For Young Investigator & Junior Professors: Confirmation of Demand of the Faculty







» Aim of the program:

Promotion of the exchange and joint cooperation of earlycareer researchers on the basis of international cooperation between working groups (AGs).

» NEW: Applications can be handed in anytime









» Eligibility

Professors and Young Investigators of TU Dresden together with a professor from the working group abroad and an early-career researcher (doctoral candidate or postdoc) as the main contact person within the working group at TU Dresden.

In order to be eligible for a project application, you have to fulfill the following requirements:

- The project application has to be a joint request.
- A cooperation between the working groups has to exists already (demonstrated by, e.g. first contact initiation, joint publications, cooperation agreements)
- At least one early career researcher from each working group must be involved in the project. Level and type of participation may vary depending on the individual needs.
- At least one doctoral candidate or postdoc of TU Dresden has to be involved in the project as a main applying contact and has to travel.







» Extent of funding:

maximum EUR 10,000.000 per project application for 18 months

» Type of funding:

Multiple projects can be funded per application!

- The mandatory module for all project applications is a research stay of a doctoral candidate or postdoc of the TU Dresden in the working group abroad (outgoing; minimum two weeks up to maximum three months)
- Further **flexible modules** can be added to the project application:
 - Research stays of further doctoral candidates, postdocs and professors/Young Investigators of the participating working groups (incoming and outgoing; up to maximum three months)
 - Joint meetings of the partner groups, organized by the involved early career researches and professors/Young Investigators, at TU Dresden or abroad (maximum five days).









» Application documents:

- Application form
- Per project member a CV
- Description of the project (max. 5 pages) including as well an outline of the planned results and perspectives for future cooperation
- Conclusive cost calculation per requested funding year (overview) taking into account all applied for short-term research stays and/or meetings of the working group (incl. name of travelling researchers, specific travel periods and estimated costs/applied funds)
- Written confirmation letter on the project cooperation submitted by the international partner(s)







General Information: Selection Process Mobility Grants

» Selection Process:

- By the Executive Committee of the GA
- In a competitive selection process

» Selection Criteria:

- Qualification of the applicant (academic performance, publications, prizes/awards)
- Quality of the research project/benefit of the participation in the e.g. applied event for the research project
- Quality of the letter of recommendation
- Social criteria (e.g. children, family members in need of care)

Maximum of 3 mobility grants per qualification phase (doctoral/postdoc phase)!
