





Paid PhD positions in academia

Full- or part-time fixed-term contracts on university budget (Haushaltsstelle) or third-party funding

University

- research associates (TV-L 13)
- research assistants (WHK) ٠

Non-university research institution

- doctoral positions (based on TVöD 13)
- project positions








Paid PhD positions in academia

Where do I find out about job postings?



For example here:

- job offers at universities (www.tu-dresden.de)
- job offers at non-university research institutions
- ask your supervisor
- job portals e.g. : <u>www.academics.de</u>











What is meant by a scholarship?

- Financial allowances
- Covering living expenses
- Purchase of equipment/materials

Long-term and short-term scholarships?

- Long-term scholarships / doctoral stipends: up to three years in general
- Short-term scholarships: up to one year or less









What does a scholarship include?



Financial benefits:

- monthly scholarship installment
- allowances for material/equipment
- family and travel allowances
- if applicable, subsidies for health insurance
- sideline activities partly possible (10 hours/week)

Idealistic benefits:

• offers of qualification and networking measures as well as career-supporting activities











Potential doctoral funding:

- Doctoral scholarships of GA / TU Dresden
- Organizations for the promotion of young talent (*Begabtenförderungswerke*) and foundations
- German Academic Exchange Service (for internationals only)



German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD)



- **Doctoral scholarships**: Prospective international doctoral candidates
- Short-term-/Long-term scholarships for research stays abroad

According to which selection criteria will be decided:

- Outstanding degree
- Convincing doctoral project (presented in the exposé and supported by the letters of recommendation)
- If applicable, verifiable commitment in the sense of the foundation's goals / funding bodies
- If applicable, your denomination in the case of denominational foundations
- Completeness of your submitted application documents

Please estimate: What percentage of all grant applications are per se formal rejections? 10 - 15%

IMPORTANT

From the idea to funding ... plan with **up to six months** or more lead time ...









Industry-sponsored doctorates

Work in a company and pursue your doctorate at the same time: The industry-sponsored doctorate makes it possible



- The topic of the doctoral thesis is usually specified by the company
- Doctoral candidates have to find a supervisor for their doctorate themselves
- Industries: Automotive, electrical engineering or telecommunications industry









External employment and self-financing



- Lack of time resources
 - Usually lack of professional
- exchange with other doctoral candidates and university lecturers / supervisors
- Often delayed completion
- of the doctorate

External employment (outside of academia)

Self-financing (Savings, family support, further income)




