## **The Graduate Academy**

### **University-wide service point**

for all doctoral candidates and their supervisors as well as for postdocs at TUD

#### **Aims**

- Creating optimal framework
   conditions for PhD students and postdocs
- Strengthening doctoral candidates' and postdocs' identity as an academic group at the university
- Supporting all forms of doctoral studies: individual as well as structured doctorates
- Currently approx. 1.900 members (open since August 2013)















## **Offers and Services**

### For GA members only:

- Qualification program specifically designed for junior researchers (transferable skills, personality development, career planning)
- Funding programs, e.g. short-term fellowships and mobility grants

### **Open to all junior researchers:**

- Individual advice and information before, during and after the PhD
- Events providing the opportunity for interdisciplinary exchange and networking







## Membership

### Voluntary membership upon application:

Doctoral candidate

 (accepted by one of TU Dresdens faculties)



#### Postdoc

(conclusion of a doctorate not longer than six years ago; employment/scholarship at the TU Dresden)



### Supervisor

(at least one of his/her supervised doctoral candidates must be member of the Graduate Academy)



### Associated membership

(doctoral candidates and postdocs engaged in collaborative projects with the TU Dresden, i.e. joint doctoral programs)





# **Qualification Program (1)**

- Approx. 100 seminars and workshops per year (both in English and in German)
- GA Future Career Programs: Academia and Business
- ZIH-login needed for online registration (can be provided for non TU Dresden members by GA)
- Registration for max. 3 seminars per semester for each GA member
- Seminars take usually place at the Graduate Academy
- Certificate of attendance













## **Qualification Program (2)**

### **Towards the PhD** / Erfolgreich promovieren

... support during the different stages of your doctoral project

**Professional in Science** / Wissenschaft in der Praxis

... developing transferable skills for every-day scientific work

Management & Leadership / Management und Führung

... preparing for leading positions in different work contexts








## **Membership Registration (1)**

#### 2. Submission of further documents:

- For doctoral candidates: Supervision Agreement (incl. working plan, download sample form on the GA website) and Acceptance as a Doctoral Candidate by the Faculty
- For postdocs: Copy of PhD certificate
- **For both:** Declaration of consent with the GA privacy statement

### 3. Confirmation of membership by GA - than:

- Participation (free of charge) in the qualification program of the GA
- Application for GA funding programs
