The international conference "ICTT: International cooperation in teacher training" falls into line with previous events for international cooperation in teacher training at TU Dresden. Following "InterBild" in 2017, "ICTT" aims to evaluate and discuss mobilities of researchers and students during their studies and internships that happened in the timeframe of 2017-2019 to develop further international cooperations in teacher training. The event is targeted at lecturers and students at TU Dresden as well as international educationalists and "Erasmus+" students from countries like Russia, Israel or Japan.

A main goal is the international exchange of pedagogical topics in teacher-training, as well as an exchange about experienced cultural distinctions between countries and teaching practices at schools abroad. However, the focus is not the alignment of concepts, but the expansion of perspectives how teacher training could be shaped in "new" and "different" ways, how mobility of students and researchers could be facilitated and how mentors at schools and universities could be supported.

In order to reach the conference's main goal selected international cooperations will be presented and the current status and prospects of internationalization at TU Dresden will be discussed. Furthermore, the various models of practical phases in teacher training in different countries will be presented and possibilities for student mobility in these phases will be debated. Finally, there will be contributions regarding existing possibilities for international experiences from different point of views.
