


## The Weiss-Livnat International MA Program in Holocaust Studies







## Sophie and Julius Ferdinand Wollf Scholarship Call for Applicants

The Weiss-Livant International MA program in Holocaust Studies is happy to allocate a **5,000 Euro scholarship** in the name of Sophie and Julius Ferdinand Wollf to a student of the Technische Universität Dresden to study the Holocaust at the University of **Haifa, Israel** in **2018-2019**.

The one-year International Master's Program in Holocaust Studies aims at cultivating future generations of Holocaust researchers and educators.

The program focuses on **Holocaust research and education with an exceptional, multi-disciplinary approach** offering courses in history, psychology, anthropology, Museology, education, International law, visual arts and literature; **excursions and visits** to relevant sites, museums and institutions and **intense training in archival research.** 

**All students are offered internship positions** in Holocaust related institutions in Israel and abroad, such as the Jewish Museum in Berlin, the Jewish Museum in Warsaw and the Jewish Museum in Budapest.

We designated one scholarship for an excellent candidate from the History Department of the Technische Universität Dresden for the academic year starting in October 2018.
