Dear LL.M.-IP student,

Your mandatory stay at Charles University (Univerzita Karlova) as part of the Master's program "International Studies in Intellectual Property Law" is about to begin and you have probably already made most of the preparations for the trip and your accommodation on site. Herewith we would like to give you some information about the crediting of your studies at Charles University.

With the LL.M. "International Studies in Intellectual Property Law" you have chosen a one-year master's program with 60 ECTS. Your study abroad accounts for 25 ECTS of this total. The grade achieved at Charles University counts for 25% of the master's grade.

1. Course selection

Regarding the lectures and examinations in Prague, two examinations and one research Essay have to be done during your studies in Prague. As you have already have chosen your courses make sure that one of them is "Intellectual property law". The other course, which will also be considered in your final grade, can be chosen freely among the Postgraduate Courses offered at Charles University. If the course "Recent Trends in European Authors` rights" is offered, this is also mandatory to our students. At the end of the semester, an Essay has to be written.
