Dear LL.M.-IP student,

Your mandatory stay at the Queen Mary University of London as part of the Master's program "International Studies in Intellectual Property Law" is about to begin and you have probably already made most of the preparations for the trip and your accommodation on site. Herewith we would like to give you some information about the crediting of your studies at the QMUL for your overall grade.

With the LL.M. "International Studies in Intellectual Property Law" you have chosen a one-year master's program with 60 ECTS. Your study abroad accounts for 25 ECTS of this total.

Please note that the QMUL's credit system differs from the continental European system. For the courses at the QMUL, either 30 credits or 15 credits are usually granted locally. In total, you should choose courses with a workload of 45 credits during your study stay at the QMUL, which will count towards your Master's degree with 25 ECTS. The grade achieved at QMUL counts for 25% of the master's grade.

## 1. Course selection

You have already chosen your courses at the QMUL. Our colleagues in London will do their best to fulfill your course wishes. Please note that a Research Essay (5000 words) is compulsory for Dresden students.
