## Das Gewichtungsproblem

In general, you must weight tables before quoting percentages from them.

The Design weight (DWEIGHT) should always be applied.

The Population size weight (PWEIGHT) should **additionally** be applied if you are looking at aggregates or averages for two or more countries combined.

Users should note that the two weights currently available do not adjust for non-response in the sample.
