<b>Beschreibung/ Ziele der Veranstaltung</b>	In our day-to-day lives as modern citizens, we regularly find ourselves existing in many different contexts. We think politically when reading the news in the morning, ethically when considering whether someone should be sent to prison, and even aesthetically when choosing how to dress or what song to listen to on our way to work. Although all of these contexts may be quite different, they share the basic fact that they are all modes of *thought*. Thus, by exploring the different ways in which we think and judge throughout these contexts we might begin to form a general picture of human thought as such. In this introductory seminar, we will study some of the key modes of thought of our political, ethical, and aesthetic lives and in so doing try to understand the kind of beings that we are. Through readings and discussions, we will explore basic concepts such as 'ideology', 'power', 'morality', and 'beauty.'
