2°ib means:

Studying 2 master programmes at the same time and being rewarded by 2 degrees after 2 years:

- Magister in the field of International Economic Relations with major in Programme of Master Studies in International Business (M. A.) at UE Wrocław
- Master of Science (M.Sc.) in International Management at TU Dresden's International Institute Zittau and at University of Applied Sciences Görlitz/Zittau at Zittau.

how is it done?

- 1. You apply at UEW or IHI for 1 of the both master courses mentioned above just as any other applicant.
- At the end of your 1st semester, you apply for 2°ib with your first grades.
- 3. If you get selected for **2°ib**, you study your 3rd semester at the partner university abroad.
