APPLICATION PROCEDURE for master study programmes at TU Dresden – International Institute (IHI) Zittau

FORM AND REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Please fill out the form in English or German readable on computer and not by hand.

Application set should <u>not</u> be stapled.

We can only accept and process <u>complete</u> applications with <u>official certified copies and</u> <u>translations</u> (English or German). Simple copies or copies certified by a notary or lawyer are not sufficient.

In case you have some documents that are printed front and back (e.g. WAEC Certificate, Bachelor's certificate...), please make sure to <u>copy and certify both sides</u>.

In case you present copies of study documents (e.g. transcript of records, degree certificate...) please make sure that <u>every page</u> is stamped and signed by the university.

- **APPLICATION form (AF) p**lease fill out the application form completely and sign it. <u>https://static.daad.de/media/daad_de/pdfs_nicht_barrierefrei/in-deutschland-studieren-forschen-lehren/zulassungsantrag_en.pdf</u>
- OFFICIAL CERTIFIED COPY (copies certified by one of German Missions in your country) and OFFICIAL CERTIFIED TRANSLATION (by a sworn translator) of your SCHOOL-LEAVING CERTIFICATE (university entrance qualification) – applicants from Nigeria, Ghana, Liberia and Gambia also submit a "WAEC or NECO-direct access card" (a scratch card to access WAEC or NECO results online)
- OFFICIAL CERTIFIED COPY (copies certified by one of German Missions in your country) and OFFICIAL CERTIFIED TRANSLATION (by a sworn translator) of your DEGREE (e. g. bachelor certificate) with a TRANSCRIPT of RECORDS (overview of marks - also as an official certified copy with an official certified translation by a sworn translator) and DIPLOMA SUPPLEMENT (if available) in German or English
- **Proof of your LANGUAGE COMPETENCE*** it means a special certificate in original (IELTS, TOEFL not older than two years) or as official certified copy (DSH, TestDaF)
- **Graduates from a German university**: matriculation certificate or de-registration certificate and "Studienverlaufsbescheinigung"
- **CURRICULUM VITAE** in English or German

- There is not any application via uni-assist or online application. Please send complete application directly by post/mail.
- We only accept official certified copies and translations.
- We only process complete applications.
- Please note the deadlines. The inbox counts.
- It is <u>not possible to study at your home country university and TU Dresden at the same</u> <u>time</u>. If you start studying at TU Dresden you need to submit a certificate that you have been taken off the university register in your home country. Otherwise it is not possible to study at TU Dresden.

VISA APPLICATION PROCEDURE

In case you are not a citizen of the EU, you need a **valid visa for studying** in Germany for the duration of the study at TU Dresden-IHI Zittau.

International students from EU countries do not need a visa.

Other international students can get information about visa application procedure at the German Missions in their home countries. Please ask there about the appointment system and procedure.

Please take care of a visa appointment at the responsible embassy on time. The appointments are quickly booked out. Visa applications should be submitted to the Embassy at least 8-10 weeks before the planned date of departure. It is not possible to apply for the visa in Germany.

To be able to get the visa converted in a residence permit for study after your arrival at Immigration department, you must be insured for the whole period of your stay. We recommend you to administrate the (German) **health insurance** in your country before departure.
