# **Single Point of Contact - SPOC**

### 1. Who is a Single Point of Contact?

(a) He / She is a student who acts as the primary point of contact between a mentoring professor and his respective mentees. The SPOC, is also a mentee of the mentoring professor.

## 2. What are his/her responsibilities?

- (a) Any common issue or topic of concern is directly contacted to the SPOC, who in turn conveys it to his mentor, discusses it and gives back the necessary feedback to his/her counterparts.
- (b) The SPOC, is also the contact person for other mentees of his/her respective mentor, for all batches of the CMS program. This step ensures a student level filtration of all recurring issues and concerns.
- (c) Any common course level matters, collected by all SPOCs from their individual group, will be discussed with the concerned student representative\* of CMS program and thereby will be resolved by making necessary communications with the concerning departments.

#### 3. What can he/she not do?

- (a) The SPOC will not come into any discussions, when a mentee has any private concerns of his/her own interest. This should only be solved privately with his/her respective mentor. Nevertheless, SPOC can utmost, in exceptional situations, set-up an individual meeting between the above two.
- (b) SPOCs are not a part of any commission (but the other way around is possible) and serve their purpose voluntarily\*\*. But any necessary guidance and monitoring required by the SPOC, will be provided from the concerned student representatives of the CMS program.
