Qualification objectives	Students are familiar with publications in a selected field of computer science research, can name the connections and recognize the need for further applications and research results.
Content	Contents of the module are the application of the techniques of scientific work in a research area of computer science as well as the evaluation of the current state of research in this research area, research on publications and the identification of additional investigations or applications in preparation for a Bachelor's thesis.
Teaching and learning methods	The module comprises seminars of 4 SWS and self-study. The teaching language of the seminars is German.
Prerequisites for participation	The competences to be acquired in the module INF-25-Ba-WIA Scientific Work are assumed.
Applicability	The module is a compulsory module in both the Bachelor's degree program in Computer Science and the Bachelor's degree program in Applied Computer Science. The module creates the prerequisites for the modules listed under prerequisites for participation.
Requirements for earning credit points	The credit points are earned if the module examination is passed. The module examination consists of a complex course of 50 hours. The examination language is German.
Credit points and grades	5 credit points can be earned through the module. The module grade corresponds to the grade of the examination.
Module frequency	The module is offered every semester.
Workload	The total workload is 150 hours.
Module duration	The module comprises one semester.
