Qualification objectives	Students are able to derive, create and process concepts for presentations, exhibitions and events in a structured way. You can evaluate the resulting ideas and concepts in terms of feasibility and feasibility.
contents	Contents of the module are event planning and management, exhibition design, long-term advertising of an event by print media, conception and design of a social media campaign, planning, conception and implementation of an information guidance system.
Forms of teaching and learning	The module includes internships in the scope of 4 SWS and self-study. The teaching language of the internships can be German or English and will be specified by the lecturer at the beginning of each semester and announced in the usual way.
Requirements for participation	In the Bachelor's programme in Computer Science, the competencies to be acquired in the modules INF-25-Ba-MCI Fundamentals of Human-Computer Interaction and INF-25-Ba-DMF Data Management Foundations are required.
usability	The module is a compulsory elective module of the Bachelor's internship in the bachelor's degree program Computer Science, which must be chosen in accordance with the annex to the examination regulations. The module creates the prerequisites for the modules, which it provides under prerequisites for participation.
Conditions for awarding credits	The credit points are earned when the module examination has been passed. The module exam consists of a complex performance of 80 hours. The language of the examination is German or English at the choice of the student.
Credits and grades	6 credit points can be earned through the module. The module grade corresponds to the grade of the examination performance.
Frequency of the module	The module is offered every semester.
workload	The total workload is 180 hours.
