Qualification objectives	Students have advanced skills in Russian for independent subject-related written and oral communication at level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. Students can largely understand complex specialist texts presented orally, express themselves clearly and fluently in detail and using complex linguistic structures on selected topics in their specialist field and use a variety of strategies to ensure comprehension. Students have intercultural competence.
Content	The content of the module in Russian includes the basics of academic language, listening strategies, reception and production of specialist and academic texts and the preparation of presentations with questions.
Teaching and learning methods	The module comprises language courses of 4 SWS and self-study.
Prerequisites for participation	Russian language skills at level B1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages are required.
Applicability	The module is a compulsory elective module of the General Qualification in the Diploma degree program in Computer Science in the foundation course, which must be selected in accordance with the annex 1 to the examination regulations. In the Bachelor's degree course in Computer Science, the module is a compulsory elective module of the General Qualification on, which must be selected in accordance with the annex to the examination regulations. In the Bachelor's degree program in Applied Computer Science, the module is a compulsory elective module of the General Qualification, which must be selected in accordance with the annex to the examination regulations. In the Master's degree program in Computer Science, the module is a compulsory elective module of the General Qualification, which must be selected in accordance with Annex 1 to the Examination Regulations. The module cannot be selected in the Master's degree program in Computer Science if this module or a module with essentially the same content from a degree program in which the admission requirements according to § 3 of the study regulations have already been met has already been completed. The module fulfills the prerequisites for the modules listed under prerequisites for participation.
Requirements for earning credit points	The credit points are earned if the module examination is passed. The module examination consists of a language examination lasting 100 minutes.
Credit points and	5 credit points can be earned through the module. The module grade

grades	corresponds to the grade of the examination.
