Qualification objectives	Students have advanced skills in French for independent job-related written and oral communication at level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. Students can largely understand job-related written or oral specialist texts, express themselves clearly and fluently in detail and using complex linguistic structures on selected topics in their specialist field and use a variety of strategies to ensure comprehension. The students have cross-professional and action-oriented skills and abilities to support written and oral communication in everyday professional life. In addition, they have intercultural competence.
Content	The content of the module in French includes communication about economic sectors and industries as well as professional and job profiles, the basics of business communication, simulation of professional ifical communication constellations, development of written communication skills and job application training.
Teaching and learning methods	The module comprises language courses of 4 SWS and self-study.
Prerequisites for participation	French language skills at level B1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages are required.
Applicability	The module is a compulsory elective module of the General Qualification in the Diploma degree program in Computer Science in the foundation course, which must be selected in accordance with the annex age 1 to the examination regulations. In the Bachelor's degree course in Computer Science, the module is a compulsory elective module of the General Qualification on, which must be selected in accordance with the annex to the examination regulations. In the Bachelor's degree program in Applied Computer Science, the module is a compulsory elective module of the General Qualification, which must be selected in accordance with the appendix to the examination regulations. In the Master's degree program ang Computer Science, the module is a compulsory elective module of the General Qualification, which must be selected in accordance with Annex 1 to the Examination Regulations . The module cannot be selected in the Master's degree program in Computer Science if this module or a module with essentially the same content from a degree program in which the admission requirements according to Section 3 of the study regulations have already been met has already been completed. The module dul creates the prerequisites for the modules listed under prerequisites for participation.

Requirements for earning credit points	The credit points are earned if the module examination is passed. The module examination consists of a language examination lasting 100 minutes.
Credit points and grades	5 credit points can be earned through the module. The module grade corresponds to the grade of the examination.
Module frequency	The module is offered every semester.
Workload	The total workload is 150 hours.
Module duration	The module comprises one semester.
