Qualification objectives	Students are familiar with the basic concepts of microeconomics. They are able to understand, analyse and transfer the individual economic decisions of households and companies to other contexts.
contents	Contents of the module are the basics of household and production theory as well as welfare economics.
Forms of teaching and learning	The module includes lectures in the scope of 2 SWS, exercises in the scope of 1 SWS, tutorials in the scope of 1 SWS and self-study. The teaching language of the lectures, exercises and tutorials is German.
Requirements for participation	In the Master's programme in Media Informatics, the basic skills to be acquired in the module INF-MI-E-NGR-VWL Economics are required.
usability	In the Master's programme in Media Informatics, the module is a compulsory elective module in the supplementary area. The module creates the prerequisites for the modules, which it names under prerequisites for participation.
Conditions for awarding credits	The credit points are earned when the module examination has been passed. The module exam consists of a 90-minute exam. The language of the exam is German.
Credits and grades	6 credit points can be earned through the module. The module grade corresponds to the grade of the examination performance.
Frequency of the module	The module is offered every summer semester.
workload	The total workload is 180 hours.
Duration of the module	The module covers one semester.
