<u>Before the exam</u>

- ✓ at least 1 week before the exam: Use your ZIH Login to access the examination platform at <u>https://exam2.zih.tu-dresden.de</u>, if you have not already done so. An initial login is necessary to create your account in the system to enable an assignment to the individual exams.
- Participation in exams is only possible by logging into the examination platform using your ZIH login. You can log in 15 minutes before the start of the exam. Be present on the platform at least 5 minutes before the start of the exam.
- ✓ Use an **up-to-date browser** (recommendation: Firefox, Chrome) for the exam, ideally on a laptop or desktop PC.
- \checkmark Make sure that you have a stable internet connection at the time of the exam.
- ✓ Please also be aware of the <u>detailed instructions</u> for taking an ONYX or Upload exam.

Immediately before the start of the exam

- ✓ **Test your internet connection** before the start of the exam.
- ✓ Check whether the communication channel is set up (Matrix Chat, Microphone works in BBB rooms, noted down the telephone number for your group).

- ✓ Before the exam begins, sign the statement confirming that you will complete the exam independently: Declaration of Originality: I am aware that I am obliged to perform this exam independently, without external help and only with the approved aids within the specified processing time. I provide references for directly and indirectly used sources. I am aware that in the event of attempted to cheat or to deceive, the performance will be rated as "insufficient" (5.0) or "failed" and that in serious cases I may be excluded from taking further examinations.
