Dear students of the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering,

with the last evening mail - which is just one week ago - there seem to have been some problems in the dispatch, so here comes another one, which contains the information from last week for safety reasons, as well as some new points, which might be important...

And so, for now, the important notes from last time, supplemented in some places by new information:

- The **registration for the exams** runs until 22.01.2023!
- Yesterday, in the event "Ingenieure exzellenten Rufs", there was once again something about the examination process, which has just landed in the Podcast **Studiendekan on Air** (<https://spoti.fi/3rM07Tf>).
- Registering for the exams also means that this time many of you will have to register via Selma for the first time - if you have any problems, please contact the exams office directly. Only there you can be helped!
- Very important - and I can get rid of the tip here right away - is the fact that the **registration at Selma is multi-level**: First you have to register in the module and then register for the exam in the corresponding course. Please only register for the modules in which you really want to take exams, or in which there really is an exam in this semester! Example: In the first semester the course on construction - there is the examination only in the summer! So do not register now (or if already done - deregister again)!!! - On the subject of examinations, there is one more important note: Due to the discontinuation of normal sick leave at the beginning of the year, a doctor's certificate is now always required in the event of **withdrawal from an examination due to illness**.
