Dear students of the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering,

The 110th Infomail since the beginning of the Corona crisis, but only 14 days since the last mail - there must be a reason for that... And apart from the fact that we are now rapidly approaching the end of the semester and I would of course like to wish you **all the best and much success for the examination period**, there are a few things that are so important and time-critical with regard to the examination period and the coming semester that I have to write this mail today and not next week (and thus really at the end of the semester).

First of all, the usual information with regard to the examination period:

- The **examination dates** can be found, as already mentioned, at <https://tud.link/3513>. You should always check here whether the dates and rooms are still correct, as changes are still being made!
- The second important point is **exam registration**. The registration deadline has passed, but you should definitely check in Selma whether you are really registered for everything you want to take this semester! Why can this be critical? The reason is the **registration logic in Selma**. The first step is to register for the module. However, this does not mean that you have registered for an examination - this only happens when you register for the specific examination in the second step! If you realize that you have not done this correctly somewhere: Immediately go to the Examinations Office with a slip of paper to correct the error. And there seem to be many such mistakes: During a small check, the Examinations Office discovered over 280 examination registrations that had not actually taken place...
- The last point for today concerns **2-factor authentication once again**: New aspects have arisen here that are really critical. The **deadline for the setup is 02.03.2024**. After this date, the ZIH will **block all logins that have not set up 2-factor authentication!** This means that you will no longer be able to access anything that requires a login to the TU system: Selma, Opal, Eduroam,... So please make sure you set up this access in the self-service portal as soon as possible and test whether your access works. Otherwise you will have really dramatic problems!
