 - Proof of achievement in Fluid Mechanics and Simulation Methods (computer-based short test) in MW-MB-ET-01
 - Protocol collection Nanostructured Materials in MW-WW-AW13
 - Written exam Food Chemistry: Reactions and functionalities of ingredients, residues, and packaging in MW-VNT-72
 - Proof of achievement Textile Machinery Investigations (computer-based comprehension test) in MW-MaTM-22

For everyone who wants to study abroad for a semester, the ERASMUS+ programme is an important point of contact. The Erasmus+ information event of the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering will take place on Thursday, 27 November 2025, from 4:40 p.m. in ZEU/148. Topics will include the application process, funding and top-ups for financing the exchange, as well as credit transfer of coursework and examinations.
