With an annual call for proposals, TU Dresden supports projects that strengthen the partnership with King's College London since 2020.

Call for projects – with King's College London in 2023

Application deadline: 23 September 2022

Projects should aim at one or more of the following objectives:

- Initiation and expansion of research collaborations and projects with King's College London
- Joint application for third-party funding for research projects with partners at King's
- (structured) exchange of PhD students, academic and non-academic staff
- joint publications
- Improving/expanding the general conditions for international cooperation in research and/or teaching (e.g. through digital formats) with partners at King's
- Strengthening the international visibility of transCampus and TUD

The following objectives are beneficial:

- Strengthening interdisciplinary collaboration
- Strengthening the collaboration with DRESDENconcept partner institutions

Further information:

- **Maximum amount: EUR 15,000 per project**
- **Funding period: 1 January 2023 to 31 December 2023**
- An ethics vote, if required, must be present at the start of the funding period

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Eligible costs:

- Travel and accommodation expenses (up to 14 days pursuant to SächsRKG for graduates; in other cases: scholarships amounting to the DAAD lump sums)
- Expenses for (virtual) workshops, scientific events;
- in the case of public events, costs for interpreters/translations, if the TUD Translation Office has no capacity
- Project-related public relations work
- Student assistants (SHK, WHK), fee contracts, contracts for work
- Project-related consumables for projects resulting in joint applications for external funding and joint publications

Not eligible:

- Basic equipment of the TUD (e.g. setting/equipping PC workstations)
- Funding of other bodies
- Decoration, tips, gifts, visa (for guests), interpreter (exception see above), (health) insurance, business/first class tickets
- Conference participation/conference subsidies/conference fees
- Translations (documents, articles, specialist publications, websites etc.)
- Specific event formats: commemorative, festive and anniversary colloquia
- Appropriations for staff – except student assistants (SHK/WHK), fee contracts, contracts for work
