Fellowships for Ph.D. Students and Postdocs

Summer Program

2 months in summer

- Eligibility:
- Be enrolled in a university graduate program.
- Hold a doctorate degree which must have been received within 6 years.

Short-term

1 - 12 months

- Eligibility:
- Be enrolled in a doctoral course and be scheduled to receive a Ph.D. within 2 years.
- Hold a doctorate which must have been received within the past 6 years.

Standard 12 – 24 months

•Eligibility:

- Be scheduled to receive a doctorate degree before the Fellowship goes into effect.
- Hold a doctorate degree which must have been received within the past 6 years.

By cooperating with AvH, JSPS reserves special quotas for the German candidates applying through AvH and they can receive other provisions and sponsorship from AvH additionally.

Pathway

12 – 24 months

- Eligibility:
- Have a desire to continue engaging in research and education at the host institution in a full-time employment capacity.
- Hold a doctorate which must have been received within the past 10 years.
- Be scheduled to receive a doctorate degree before the Fellowship goes into effect.

Fellowships for Researchers

Long-term

2 - 10 months

- Eligibility:
- Be in a position equivalent to a university professor, associate professor or assistant professor in Japan.
- Hold a doctorate degree prior to 6 years or more and are continuing to do research in a university or non-profit research institution may be eligible.

Shor-term

14 - 60 days

- Eligibility:
- Overseas researchers in a position equivalent to a university professor or associate professor.
- Apply to: JSPS http://www.jsps.go.jp/english/ e-inv/index.html

Short-term S

7 - 30 days

- Eligibility:
- Researchers who are Nobel laureates or recipients of similarly high-level international prizes with exceptionally outstanding records of research achievements and who currently occupy a leading position in their subject field.
