Responsibilities of the Chair

The chair is associated with the position of a Chief Physician at the Department of Anesthesiology, Critical Care Medicine, and Pain Medicine at Chemnitz University Hospital gGmbH. The department covers the entire spectrum of anesthesiology, ranks among the largest anesthesiology departments in Saxony, and plays a central role in interdisciplinary patient care. It offers a comprehensive range of state-of-the-art anesthetic procedures and innovative intensive care treatment concepts.

The chair is linked to the strategic development of the hospital in Chemnitz. This includes, in particular, strengthening interdisciplinary and cross-sectoral care structures in intensive care medicine, emergency medicine, and pain management; further developing clinical processes; and establishing a distinct profile in selected areas of care. At the same time, the professorship contributes strategically to the academic development of the TUD's Chemnitz Medical Campus. The academic profile encompasses care-oriented, evidence-based clinical research with a particular focus on digitized and cross-sectoral care concepts.

The chair is responsible for initiating, conducting, and further developing clinical research projects and promotes participation in national and international research networks in close cooperation with Dresden University Hospital and other academic institutions at TUD.

Another focus lies in the conceptual development and implementation of competency-based teaching and training concepts within the MEDiC model degree program. The chair contributes to the curricular development of the program and ensures the integration of clinical expertise into university teaching. In addition, the scope of responsibilities includes the promotion of early-career researchers as well as the maintenance and advancement of the field of anesthesiology.

The teaching load has been reduced to a maximum of 4 course hours per semester.

Requirements for your profile

We are seeking a nationally and internationally recognized professional (m/f/d) with a track record of academic excellence, demonstrated through international publications and a successful record of securing external funding. You have extensive experience in clinical anesthesiology and interdisciplinary critical care medicine, as well as in operating room management, and possess proven expertise in the strategic development of clinical processes and interdisciplinary collaboration. In addition, you hold a qualification in medical education (e.g., MME) and have expertise in organizing and conducting academic teaching, including curriculum development. We also welcome your commitment to the promotion and training of young clinical and scientific talent, as well as to specialist medical training.

Your involvement in academic self-governance is a given. You possess relevant and appropriate leadership, management, and diversity skills and are familiar with the demands of managing a clinical department in a university setting. Your independent, thoughtful approach to work, strategic thinking, sense of responsibility, and ability to motivate and lead interdisciplinary, diverse teams round out your profile.

We expect you have a completed university degree in medicine and board certification in anesthesiology, along with additional training in critical care and emergency medicine. In all other respects, the requirements for appointment, the official duties and the administrative status are governed by §§ 59, 69, 71 of the Act on Higher Education Institutions in the Free State of Saxony (SächsHSG) and the Regulations on Duties and Responsibilities at Higher Education Institutions (HSDAVO).

We are offering you a senior research leadership position at a university-affiliated tertiary care hospital with excellent opportunities for clinical and research development. You will work in an interdisciplinary and research-intensive environment with a wide range of collaboration opportunities and benefit from state-of-the-art research and teaching infrastructure. The attractive compensation package, which includes performance-based components, is based on the W-salary scale (W2). You will also receive a company pension plan and opportunities for additional private retirement savings. At the same time, you will be appointed to a professorship under the Thuringian model. TU Dresden grants you the legal status of a university professor; this does not establish an employment or service relationship with TU Dresden.
