The chair is affiliated to the Department of Dermatology and is intended to continue and expand the existing expertise in the field of dermatological oncology. The focus of the chair includes the development of clinically oriented and basic research projects in dermatooncology, as well as the initiation of and participation in (inter)national clinical studies, including with the pharmaceutical industry. As a future professor of dermatological oncology, you (m/f/x) will work on the tasks associated with this position in an interdisciplinary concept and also cooperate with the Cluster of Excellence Center for Regenerative Therapies Dresden (CRTD) and the University Cancer Center (NCT/UCC). In your tasks, you will take appropriate account of gender- and diversity-related aspects, including in your research questions and treatment concepts. The chair is associated with a senior physician function and the management of the Skin Tumor Center at the Department of Dermatology.

As the future position holder, you are nationally and internationally known as a research personality in dermatological oncology, both with your successful, internationally visible publication activity and corresponding experience in acquiring third-party funding and your experience in conducting clinical studies. You also have appropriate leadership and management experience. We also welcome the fact that you will inspire our students with your teaching concepts for your subject and look forward to your commitment to the promotion and training of young clinical scientists and to academic self-administration. Your tasks in patient care and teaching require a good knowledge of the German language.

Appointment requirements include a completed degree in human medicine, a doctorate, habilitation or equivalent achievements, pedagogical aptitude and knowledge of university didactics as well as a board certification in dermatology. The requirements for appointment, the official duties and the administrative status are governed by §§ 59, 69, 71 of the Act on Higher Education Institutions in the Free State of Saxony (SächsHSG) and the Saxon Regulation on Official Duties at Higher Education Institutions (HSDAVO).

The employment of professors with medical tasks is generally carried out within the framework of non-tariff employment contracts with basic remuneration as well as performance and success-dependent remuneration components.

The Faculty of Medicine strives to employ more women in academia and research. We therefore expressly encourage women to apply.
