You (m/f/x) will represent the field of microbial and infection immunology in its entirety in teaching and research. We would like you to participate in existing research consortia and cooperate with institutions at TUD Dresden University of Technology and non-university research institutions. We expect a high degree of cooperation from you, as well as a special commitment to teaching (medical microbiology and virology) and welcome your participation in academic self-administration.

We are seeking an internationally renowned research personality in microbial and infection immunology, particularly in the field of pathogen-host interaction, the area of the microbiome and its interface to immunometabolism, taking into account gender-dependent factors. As a successful candidate, you already have proven excellent, internationally visible publication activity in the field of microbial and infection immunology and have extensive experience in obtaining external third-party funding. Appointment requirements include a university degree in medicine or natural sciences (e.g. biology, chemistry, biochemistry), a doctorate, habilitation or equivalent achievements, pedagogical aptitude and knowledge of university didactics. Your willingness to support microbiological diagnostics is welcome. Applicants must fulfil the employment qualification requirements of § 59 of the Institutions of Higher Education Act in the Free State of Saxony (SächsHSG). The employment of professors with medical duties takes place within the framework of non-tariff employee contracts with basic remuneration as well as performance- and success-related remuneration components.
