

## **The Chair for Cognitive and Clinical Neuroscience is currently looking for: Student Assistants (SHK)**

Our group investigates neural mechanisms underlying the processing of sensory information in the field of interpersonal communication and learning.

We are currently looking for motivated and enthusiastic student assistants for two functional magnetic resonance imaging (fMRI) studies – a study investigating auditory processing and a study investigating the mechanisms supporting face-identity recognition in the human brain. Both studies involve neurotypical participants, as well as those with developmental dyslexia ([tu-dresden.de/mn/psychologie/ifap/kknw/forschung/LRS](https://tu-dresden.de/mn/psychologie/ifap/kknw/forschung/LRS)) or developmental prosopagnosia ([tu-dresden.de/mn/psychologie/ifap/kknw/forschung/prosop](https://tu-dresden.de/mn/psychologie/ifap/kknw/forschung/prosop)). It is anticipated that the student assistant will work on parts of both projects.

**Tasks:** Organisation of participant recruitment, participation in data collection, and involvement in conducting fMRI and behavioural experiments onsite at the TUD Neuroimaging Centre.

**We offer:** Comprehensive insight into a cognitive and clinical neuroscience lab, involvement in an international research environment, possibilities for further professional development and methodical competence, flexible working hours. Students with a keen interest in cognitive neuroscience research are encouraged to apply.

### **Requirements:**

- Student of psychology, medicine or related field
- Ability to work responsibly and independently
- Ability to work in a team
- Availability to work on Friday evenings and Saturday mornings (note this is not every week, and can be adjusted based on schedule)
- Native German speaker and excellent command of the English language
- Favourable:
  - Experience in conducting psychological experiments and data analysis
  - Long-term involvement

The contract of employment is based on the WissZeitVG and is initially limited to three months, with the option of extension. Working hours will be approx. **15 hours per week**. Scheduling of working hours is flexible and can be stipulated.
