



Information on the Processing of Personal Data

According to Art. 4 No. 1 GDPR, personal data includes all information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person. An identifiable natural person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, or one or more factors specific to that natural person, such as their mental identity.

Before registering the Bachelor's, Master's or Diploma thesis (hereinafter referred to as thesis), it shall be ascertained whether it can be carried out with or without personal data of third parties. If only anonymous data (i.e., no personal data) will be processed, this data is not subject to the provisions of data protection.

If the processing of personal data of third parties is necessary for the substantive performance of the thesis, these are fully subject to the relevant provisions of data protection. In such cases, the student herself/himself has to inform the Data Protection Officer of TU Dresden about the matter and seek advice before registering the thesis in the Academic Affairs Office:

As far as the purpose of the research permits, the characteristics with the help of which a personal reference can be made shall be stored separately and deleted as soon as the purpose justifies their deletion.
