Hirokazu Narita graduated from Aoyama Gakuin University in 1994 and obtained Dr. Sci. degree from Ibaraki University in 1999 working in Separation Chemistry Laboratory at Japan Atomic Energy Research Institute (JAERI). After working at JAERI as a postdoctoral research fellow, he moved to National Institute of Advanced Industrial Science and Technology (AIST) as a researcher in 2002. He is currently a group leader of Resources Refining Chemistry Research Group at AIST. His research interests include ligand (extractant) designs for solvent extraction of metals and coordination chemistry in solution, focusing at present on PGM extraction and structural analyses of metal complexes in solution by means of X-ray and neutron spectroscopies (e.g., XAFS, SANS).
