Toshiaki Murai obtained his master degree in 1982 at Osaka University and became a research associate in 1983 at the Professor Kato's group at Gifu University. After receiving Ph.D. in 1986 from Osaka University under the guidance of Professors Noboru Sonoda and Shinji Murai, he worked as a postdoctoral fellow at Professor Jonathan Sessler's group at University of Texas from 1986 to 1988.
