Chemists)
from the summer semester 2018**

These regulations apply to all students in the degree program in Food Chemistry.

On the basis of Section 26 (1) sentence 3 of the Saxon Higher Education Act (Sächsisches Hochschulgesetz – SächsHSG) of June 11, 1999 (SächsGVBl. p. 293), Technische Universität Dresden issues the following regulations.

§ 1

Academic title

Graduates of Technische Universität Dresden who have successfully passed the examinations of the second examination section of the *Staatsprüfung* for *staatlich geprüfte Lebensmittelchemiker* are awarded the academic title "*Diplom-Lebensmittelchemiker*" or "*Diplom-Lebensmittelchemikerin*" (short form: "Dipl.-Leb.Chem.", in English: *Diplom Food Chemist*).

§ 2

Requirements

Requirements for the *Diplom* title to be awarded:

1. passing the oral examinations of the second section of *Staatsprüfung* for *staatlich geprüfte Lebensmittelchemiker*
2. successfully defending the scientific thesis
3. providing proof of additional studies amounting to a minimum of 8 weekly semester hours from a list of subjects specified by the Examination Committee for the degree program in Food Chemistry.

§ 3

Application

(1) Immediately after passing the examinations of the second section of the *Staatsprüfung* for *staatlich geprüfte Lebensmittelchemiker*, the graduate must apply to the Chairperson of the Examination Committee for the Food Chemistry degree program at Technische Universität Dresden to be awarded the *Diplom* title. They must submit the certificates pursuant to § 2.

(2) The Examination Committee for the Food Chemistry degree program at Technische Universität Dresden decides on the application.

§ 4

Degree certificate

(1) If the requirements pursuant to § 2 are met, the Examination Office of the Faculty of Chemistry and Food Chemistry issues a *Diplom* certificate authenticating that the academic title has been awarded.

(2) The *Diplom* certificate bears the date of the defense of the scientific thesis and is signed by both the Rector of the Technische Universität Dresden and the Chairperson of the Examination Committee for the degree program in Food Chemistry at Technische Universität Dresden, and it bears the seal of the Technische Universität Dresden.
