The Research Training Group is a fully interdisciplinary project with students from engineering and the social sciences and co-financed by the Boysen Foundation and Technische Universität Dresden. Students applying for membership must give proof that they are ready to incorporate a strong interdisciplinary approach in their research and to cooperate closely with doctoral students from other disciplines. Applicants must have a better than average university degree in the field of their research, fulfill the requirements of the respective regulations for dissertations in the faculty in which they seek their doctoral degree, and show a strong motivation for interdisciplinary research and teamwork.

Doctoral students admitted to the Research Training Group will receive initially a scholarship for one year with the possibility for an extension for another two years, starting between March 1st and September 1st, 2015. Each of the twelve doctoral students involved will have at least one advisor from engineering and one from social sciences. The program includes regular seminars on research-related topics and on soft skills as well as participation in workshops and conferences.

Applications must include a letter of motivation, a CV and copies of previous university degrees. Admittance will be decided by the Board of the Boysen-TU Dresden-Graduiertenkolleg. The scholarship amounts to a tax-exempted income of 1,800 Euro/month.
