Courses for KUINEP	The Institute for Liberal Arts and Sciences (ILAS) offers wide variety of courses in English (approx. 350+) for both Japanese and international students, which cover Humanities/Social/Natural Sciences and are designed for mainly 1st and 2nd year students.			
Japanese Language Classes	Variety of courses (absolute beginner/intermediate/advanced) to learn and improve Japanese proficiency are available for international students. The maximum number to be registered is 4 courses (8 credits) for KUINEP and GEA students. GESR students can take only non-credit classes.			
Student Lounge KIZUNA	The facility features a Reading Room, stocked with language learning materials, and a Salon where international students can receive advising services.
