Credit system

1 Credit = 50 minutes (1 Credit hour) per week

1 Credit hour lecture needs 2 Credit hours outside the classroom (for homework and tutorial etc.)

So 3 Lectures a week = 3 + (3x2) = 9 Credit course

2.5 hours of Lab work = 3 Credit hours

In any given semester, a student should not be required to register more than 66 credit hours. This means a maximum time commitment of about 55 clock hours every week.
